Why Ash Wednesday? Why Lent? Two good questions!

Not being a “cradle Lutheran” I remember asking those two questions. I remember many of my classmates leaving school late morning, then returning to school with black crosses on their foreheads. I remember the intense discussions about what it was that they were going to give up during the 40 days of Lent chocolate-soda-meat! I didn’t understand the *hoopla* of the day before Ash Wednesday known by many as “Shrove Tuesday” or “Fat Tuesday” the last chance to feast and indulge before Lent. My dentist even made donuts and gave them to his patients if they happened to have an appointment on Shrove Tuesday. This was all foreign territory for me, and with all of this going on around me, I could never get a clear explanation what it was all about. I wonder how many folks who we encounter in our daily lives don’t understand either?

What an incredible opportunity for us!! Ashes tell us the good news of the Gospel! You see, ashes aren’t just smeared randomly or haphazardly across people’s foreheads. The ashes are given in the shape of the cross. When we receive them, we are reminded that Jesus took on the fullness of our humanity. He who was sinless became our sin. Jesus was crucified on a cross. He was crucified for you - for me - for all of his beloved children. Lent is our time to reflect on our own sinfulness, our own humanity, our own mortality, and our need for a Savior who is Jesus Christ. This is our public witness and not to be kept to ourselves, but shared...especially when folks want to know the “why” of what we are doing! And so...I invite you to share this Good News ...the meaning of Ash Wednesday and Lent over these next 40 days and beyond. Never doubt God’s ability to use our most simple acts of public witness to proclaim the Easter promise...the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, our Savior and our Lord!

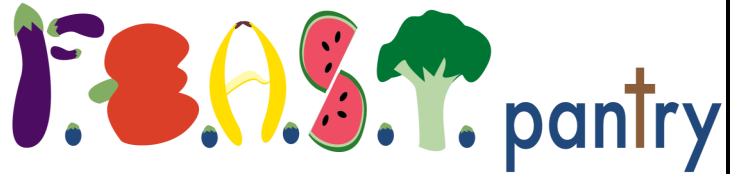

## Strengthening Congregational Stewardship The Basics

Model in the Congregation what you want members to practice

- ☆ **An attitude of Gratitude** – We are blessed by God, express that in worship, meetings, newsletters, etc. find ways to give thanks
- ☆ **An attitude of Sufficiency** – God will give us enough for our needs AND to share with others (II Cor 8) Good stewardship is based on our faith in that promise from God and that faith is practiced by what and how we communicate about finances.
- ☆ **First Fruits Giving** – we want members to give first to God and to be confident they will still have enough for themselves. The congregation models this by giving first to Partnership Support, with confidence there will be enough for our ministry.
- ☆ **Proportional Giving** - that strives for Tithing and beyond. We encourage members to give proportionately – in accordance with what they have. We should model that and work to give at least 10% in Partnership support.
- ☆ **Intentional Giving** – we encourage members to make a commitment – for their sake, so that they can express their intent to God and plan within their budget to meet that commitment as they do for other commitments – mortgage/rent; food; car; insurance, etc. So our congregation makes a commitment for our church and support our programs.
- ☆ **Regular Giving** – we encourage members to give weekly or monthly, knowing that is how we fulfill most of our budgeted expenses. Methods like Simply Giving, or an automatic bank payment are increasingly used. So the congregation should give its proportional share of Partnership support each month.

The remaining badges can be chosen from a variety of topics. An Eagle Scout must demonstrate leadership, and complete a significant service project.



## Amy Wulffleff

The Lamb Award is a national recognition bestowed on Lutheran adults (including laypersons, pastors, professional church workers, men and women) by the National Lutheran Association on Scouting [NLAS]. (The NLAS is formed by and responsible to the youth ministry departments of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America [ELCA] and The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod [LCMS].)

The purpose of The Lamb Award is twofold:

- 1) to acknowledge the distinguished service of Lutheran adults in fostering the spiritual growth of youth through church and civic youth serving agency programs (Boy Scouts of America, Girl Scouts of the U.S.A., American Heritage Girls, Camp Fire USA, and 4-H);
- 2) to increase the use and quality of the civic agency programs in Lutheran congregations as a part of their ministries with youth. Self and spouse nominations will not be accepted.

The Lamb award package contains a medal that can be worn around the neck, a lapel pin and an 8 ½" x 11" personalized color certificate.
