#### "Calls, Gathers, Enlightens and makes Holy"

On May 19, we will celebrate the Day of Pentecost which many consider to be the birth of the Christian Church. Falling 50 days after the Jewish festival of Passover, (and Jesus' resurrection), it was the day that the Holy Spirit suddenly came from heaven. It sounded like a rush of wind, and appeared as "divided tongues of fire," with a tongue of fire resting on each disciple. In Acts 2:4, St. Luke writes, "All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability." This Holy Spirit inspired Peter to openly proclaim the good news of Jesus to the Jewish pilgrims who had come to Jerusalem from every corner of world to celebrate the Passover. But, by the end of the day, about 3,000 of them were baptized in the name of Jesus Christ and received the gift of the Holy Spirit as well.


What's important for us to notice, is the difference that baptism and the Holy Spirit has on the lives of those early Christian converts. The book of Acts records that they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, fellowship, breaking bread and prayers. They don't simply return to "life as usual" in some remote corner of the world. They form a community of faith, where they dedicate their lives to supporting one another and studying the apostles' teachings, while living, eating and praying together. These believers know firsthand the challenges and perils of living in a *NON*-Christian world. This is why they gather together to form what we call "the communion of saints" in the Apostle's Creed. It provides mutual support.

In his Small Catechism, Martin Luther recognizes the need for mutual support among those who believe in Jesus. He begins his explanation of the third Article of the Apostle's Creed by admitting, "I believe that by my own understanding or strength I cannot believe in Jesus Christ my Lord or come to him, but instead the Holy Spirit has called me through the gospel, ..." Luther further explains that the Holy Spirit, "*calls, gathers, enlightens*, and *makes holy* the whole Christian church on earth and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one common, true faith." In other words, Christians need to be connected to other believers for their faith to remain effective and strong. This is especially important in our online and isolated world.


We all know the temptations of this world that St. Paul describes in Galatians 5:19. "Now the works of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity, debauchery," which seek to **separate** us from God while "the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control." (Galatians 5:22-23) These draw us **closer** to God and one another.

This year, my Pentecost prayer is that the Holy Spirit will call and gather *US* again, that we may be enlightened to love and serve all people in Jesus' name. Come, Holy Spirit! Gather Christ's Church!
